Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, the Hon'ble Prime Minister has been emphasizing the selection of sites for various projects / institutions / schemes through the "Challenge Method". In this context, a Group of Secretaries (GoS) was constituted to formulate Guidelines with a view to encouraging healthy competition amongst States / UTs as well as to ensure stakeholders commitment for timely execution and to promote transparency. Guidelines recommended by GoS have been finalized in consultation with NITI Aayog who have also consulted the various States / UTs. A copy of these Guidelines is enclosed.

2. These Guidelines provide a generic framework for adopting the Challenge Method in site selection for Central Sector projects / institutions / schemes both in greenfield & brownfield. The Guidelines also include an indicative list of sectors and projects wherein the Challenge Method can be adopted. Further, it lays down the process to be followed along with the indicative criteria for evaluation of proposals. Illustrative parameters along with suggested weights have also been suggested. However, these Guidelines offer adequate flexibility to Ministries / Departments who may appropriately adapt them, keeping in view their specific sectoral requirements.

3. It is requested that these Guidelines may henceforth be adopted wherever applicable. These may also be disseminated to all concerned under your administrative jurisdiction for guidance and compliance.
