**CORRIGENDUM E-TENDER NOTICE**

In pursuance of the direction of Honorable Delhi High Court, New Delhi Judgment dated 19.04.2017 and reference earlier Council's e-tender published on NIC Portal on 22.12.2016 and subsequent corrigendum published on 09.01.2017, 12.01.2017 and 23.01.2017, the last date to receive online tenders for the empanelment of manufacturers for the supply of educational kits is hereby **extended upto 2.30 pm on 12.5.2017**. Accordingly, all the prospective manufacturers who become eligible by virtue of the corrigendum issued by NCERT on 23.01.2017 on the NIC Portal, are requested to submit their technical bids through online along with samples of Kits physically in the DEK of NCERT as well as submit the online Bill of quantity (BOQ)/financial bid. Those firm who have already submitted their online technical bid and samples of KITS need not submit the online tender as well as samples afresh. However, the critical dates for the revised schedule are as under.

1) In accordance with the direction of Honorable Delhi High Court, New Delhi, the prospective eligible bidders are requested to upload the certificate along with the technical bid indicating that the firm falls under 'white industry category' issued by Pollution Control Board of respective State. In case, the firm/industry does not fall under the white industry category, they may submit the Pollution Under Control certificate (PUC) issued by concerned State/Authority.

2) Prospective eligible firms are also requested to inspect the samples available in the laboratory of DEK, NCERT till the closing date.
