Essential Qualifications and Pay scales:

PROFESSOR (Existing Scale of pay : Rs.37400-67000 with AGP-10,000)

- A.** (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level Institution/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicators (APIs) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS),
- (v) Two years of field work comprising teaching at the school level.

OR

- B** An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/ relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (Existing Scale of pay : Rs. 37400-67000 with AGP-9000)

- i. Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/Industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- v. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicators (APIs) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).
- vi. Two years of field work comprising teaching at the school level.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (Existing Scale of pay Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP-6000)

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this Clause, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the U.G.C. (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

v. Two years of field work comprising teaching at the school level.

LIBRARIAN (Pay Band Rs. 37,400 – 67,000 with AGP Rs. 10,000)

- i. A Master's Degree in Library Science/Information Science/Documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade B in the UGC seven points scale and consistently good academic record set out in the UGC Regulations.
- ii. At least Thirteen years as a Deputy Librarian in a university library or Eighteen years' experience as a College Librarian.
- iii. Evidence of innovative library service and organization of published work.

Headmistress/Headmaster (Existing Scale of Pay : Rs.15,600 – Rs. 39,100 with GP Rs. 7,600) (PB-III) (On Deputation Basis)

- i. Master's Degree from recognized University with atleast 50% marks in aggregate.
- ii. B.Ed. or equivalent teaching degree.
- iii. Age limit – Minimum 35 years and maximum 50 years. Age relaxation for SC/STs and other categories as applicable under the Govt. of India Rules would be applicable. No upper age limit for Council employee.

PGT(Chemistry)- Chemistry/Bio.Chemistry
PGT(Pol.Science)- Pol.Science
PGT(Geography)- Geography
PGT(Commerce)- Commerce with Accountancy/cost Accounting/Financial Accountancy as a major subject of study. Holder of Degrees of M.Com in Applied/Business Economics shall not be eligible.
 2. Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Application.

B.Sc.(Computer Science)/BCA or Equivalent and Post Graduate Degree in any subject from a recognized university

Post Graduate Diploma in Computer and Post Graduate degree in any subject from a recognized university

Or

'A' Level from DOEACC and Post Graduate degree in any subject

Or

'B' or 'C' Level from 'DOEACC' Ministry of Information and Communication Technology

Age limit: 30 years relaxable upto five years in the case of Council's employees
