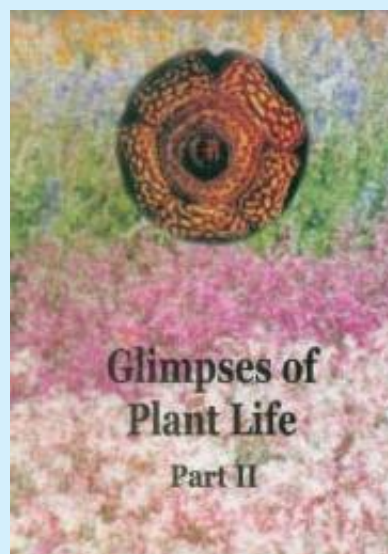
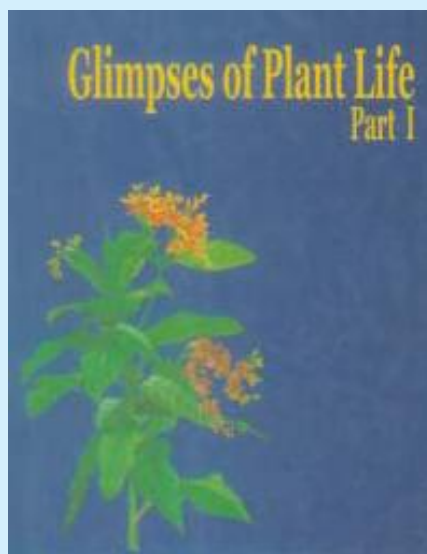
Conducting Youth Parliament

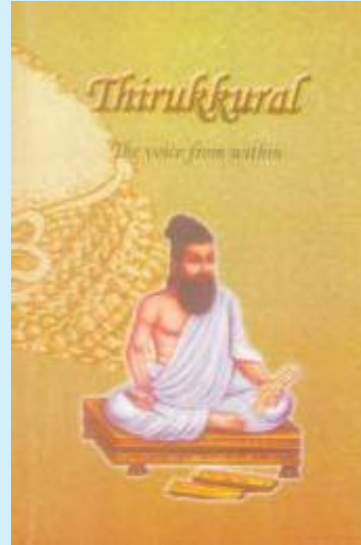

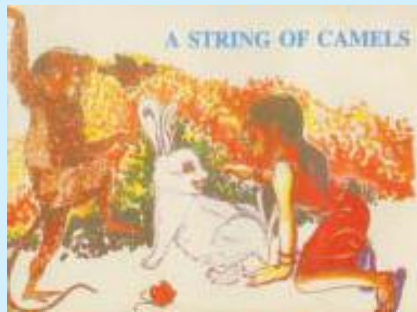

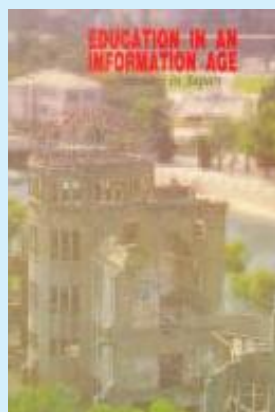
