**Tenure:** Up to 31.03.2023 from the date of joining.

**Age limit:** Below 40 years (5 years relaxation for SC/ST and women candidates).

**Fellowship:** Consolidated remuneration @ Rs.25,000/- per month (NET qualified) or Rs. 23,000/- per month (Non-NET).

**Eligibility:**

Post Graduate Degree as mentioned in the Essential Qualifications against each project with minimum 55% marks or equivalent for general category (50% marks or equivalent in case of SC/ST/PH).

**Desirable qualification for all posts**

- Knowledge of computer applications

The **walk-in-interview will be held on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022** in Department of Curriculum Studies and Development, CIET Building, NCERT, Sri Aurobindo Marg, New Delhi - 110 016. **The registration of eligible candidates will be done from 9.30 AM to 11.00 AM only.** The candidates may contact the office in Room No. 210, CIET Building, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, NCERT, New Delhi.
