
Notification

1.	Qualification	Essential: (a) Masters Degree in Economics/Education/Social Science with minimum 55% marks. (SC/ST/PH candidates are eligible with minimum of 50% marks in relevant master degree). Desirable: (a) Experience in (1) B. Ed./M. Ed. (with Social Science/Economics /History). (2) Research or teaching experience at Secondary Stage (Classes IX and X) Social Science subject. (3) Working with children-development/review of resource material for children/teachers. (4) Working knowledge of Computer in Hindi and English for data processing and preparing Report. (5) Efficient in organising virtual meetings with the national level institutions/libraries/museums in Hindi and English for collection and identification of the materials etc. (6) National Eligibility Test qualified.
2.	Age Limit	Should be below 40 years as per UGC guidelines (05 years relaxation in case of SC/ST & females candidates).
3.	Tenure	upto 31 st March, 2021 from the date of joining.


1. The candidate who had already worked as Junior Project Fellow (JPF) in the NCERT for two years and more need not apply again.

5. The candidate may ensure that he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions as mentioned above.
6. No TA/DA will be paid by the NCERT for attending the interview.
7. The selected candidate will be required to join immediately.
