## **GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS**

### **ARTICLE SUBMISSION PROCEDURE**

#### **Format of the Manuscript**

Articles must be sent in MS Word format written in English language, to the Academic Editor of the journal by e-mail to the [school.science@ncert.nic.in](mailto:school.science@ncert.nic.in)

The Title must be in Times New Roman font of 14-point size. The main text must be in Times New Roman font of 12-point size.

The Manuscript must contain Abstract, Keywords, Main text area, Conclusion and References.

#### **Reference Style and Citations**

Citations should follow the referencing style prescribed by the American Psychological Association (Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 7th Edition, 2020). For the latest APA guidelines, authors can also refer to APA (American Psychological Association) style. Citation examples of a journal article and a book are given below for quick reference.

## IMPORTANT FILES TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CORRESPONDING AUTHOR

**File-1:** Title Page with author(s) details (Name, Affiliation, E-Mail ID, ORCID ID, contact number and postal addresses of all the contributors). It is mandatory to mention ORCID ID for the author(s).

**File-2:** An Abstract within 150–200 words along with 5–7 keywords. The abstract should contain the purpose, methodology, findings, and implications of the study.

**File-3:** The Main Manuscript file must not include name and affiliation of the author(s). In case the manuscript is based on a case study, research problem, or project undertaken the submissions should range from 3000 to 8000 words. Notes, comments, or observations on policies should range from 3000 to 5000 words. Similarly, book reviews including abstract should range from 1500 to 2500 words. Charts, tables, diagrams or other allied objects as mentioned in the mail file must also be submitted in separate files for more clear/high resolution quality.

**File-4:** Diagrams or Line Drawings should be submitted in complete form, separately in JPEG files (with resolution of 600 dpi), neatly numbered for identification and clearly indicating their position in the text. Tables can be given as a part of the text. Captions should be provided whenever necessary.

**File-5:** Tables (If any)

**File-6:** A Plagiarism Report within the 10% threshold.

**File-7:** AI content report.

**File-8:** An Undertaking stating that *“I have read the publication guidelines of the NCERT journal and confirm that my manuscript complies with them. I confirm that the citation style of the manuscript is according to APA Style Manual, 7th Edition. I declare that the manuscript is original, has not been submitted elsewhere or published earlier, and does not breach any provisions of the copyright laws. A similarity report, as required by the regulations of Research and Publication Ethics, is attached.”*
